

CodeMed: Immersive Learning for Teens

The Center for Experiential and Applied Learning (CEAL) encompasses the simulation, ultrasound, anatomy, and standardized patient programs and resources within Wake Forest Baptist Health. CEAL teaches a variety of learner groups including medical students, physician assistant students, nursing students, residents, faculty, and other healthcare professionals at Wake Forest Baptist Health in clinical techniques and interdisciplinary care of patients.

As an offering to the community, CEAL hosts a STEM-based **CodeMed Program** designed to advance the delivery of healthcare by providing a hands-on, immersive learning experience in the field of health sciences to **future clinical professionals**. To this end, CEAL engages middle and high school students in discovery and firsthand experiences related to structure and function of the heart, the respiratory system, the skeletal system, or the female reproductive system (as it relates to childbirth).

Who Is Eligible?

- Middle and High School classes (7-12th grade)
- Priority given to school groups/classes with demonstrated academic ability and motivation in health science fields of study and/or students interested in healthcare-related fields

What Is Required?

- Completed class application
- Support and letter of recommendation from a school administrator
- Commitment to the event schedule and travel to Wake Forest School of Medicine for the hands-on event when dates are provided

When Does It Take Place?

The CodeMed Program takes place on select dates in January, February, and March. Dates for 2020 will be confirmed by **December 20, 2019**.

What is the Application Process?

Teachers must complete the class application by **October 1, 2019**. There are no exceptions to this deadline.

Additional Information

- All applications must be submitted by a teacher from a NC middle or high school (or a homeschool instructor in NC).
- Acceptance notification will be sent to the nominating teacher.
- Selected schools who attend the CEAL CodeMed Program **MUST** provide their own transportation to the event.
- Selected school classes must be accompanied by a teacher and one adult for every 10 students (max of 4 adults; max of 40 students)
