Student Internship Program Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Who can participate in a Maya Angelou Center for Health Equity (MACHE) Internship?

MACHE Internships are open to undergraduate, graduate, and medical students who have an interest in health equity/health disparities programming and/or research.

How do I apply for a MACHE Internship?

Please complete the internship application (link available on our website). Once you have submitted your application we will be back in touch with you within 2 weeks. In order to be considered, applications <u>must</u> be received at least 4 months prior to the desired internship period. Approximate timeframes for internships are as follows (but are flexible):

Program Period	Dates	Latest Application Due Date
Fall	August 15 th – December 15 th	April 1
Spring	January 15 th – May 15 th	September 1
Summer	June 1 st – August 31 st	February 1

How many MACHE Internships are available?

Typically, we have 1-2 internships available during each academic program period (i.e. Fall, Spring, Summer).

Are MACHE Internships paid?

Whether or not a specific internship will be paid will be determined by MACHE following 1) acceptance of internship application and 2) determination of internship goals/aims.

***If you are a Wake Forest School of Medicine Medical Student, the Medical Student Research Program (https://ctsi.wakehealth.edu/medical-student-research-program) offers a paid summer research experience in multiple departments across the WFSM, of which MACHE is a participating Center (this is an additional opportunity for a paid internship).
